

Dollars and Sense

Brothers how close are you now to having have \$100,000 saved in your saving account? Six years ago I laid out a plan for you to begin that journey to be completed by 2020. We now only have six years left on the goal.

If you lost the plan or missed reading the newsletter, let's review.

The original question was: After 12 years, why do you not have \$100,000 in a saving account? You probably assume it's because you were not earning enough money, but the truth is that for most of us it has very little to do with the amount of money we make. It's the way that we treat money in our daily life.

Here are four possible reasons why you don't have that amount in your savings account and the fifth will be your guide to getting that number by 2024.

- 1. You are too concern about what your neighbors think: Why are you competing against your neighbor? Those material possessions are not assets they are a liability. You are wasting your money on items to impress others instead of building your wealth.
- 2. You do not know what patients mean: Before credit cards, it was difficult to spend more than what you had in your bank account. If you have any credit card debt it is because you couldn't wait until you had enough money to purchase something in cash. Do you realize you are making Credit Cards and Banks rich while you are keeping yourself in debt?
- **3**. **You got a nasty habits**: Are you drinking or smoking? You are throwing away money that could make you WEALTHY. You are not only paying for those items but those items can cost you higher insurance rates.
- **4. You have not set any goals**: Brothers I always say THINK ABOUT YOUR FUTURE. You have to have a plan to succeed. You need to set weekly, monthly, and yearly saving goals. Everyone wants to be rich, but what steps are you following to make sure you reach that goal?
- **5. You Need to Be Prepared and Use Your Resources**: Make sacrifices now so in 2024, which is 10 years from now, you can have \$100,000 or at minimum \$50,000. That number may seem huge but it is simple to obtain. Simple Math...This may require you to obtain a part-time job or if you have a spouse you can go in half and half. I always say 2 incomes are better than one.

You have 10 years to reach \$100,000. Every year you must save \$10,000.00, Every month you must save \$833.33, Every week you must save 192.31.

So the Finally Question is do you want a savings account with \$100,000 or will you continue to give excuses?

Start listening to the bible if you are pressed for time to read it (there are several free audio bibles online). Start calling an elderly member of the church once a week to check on them. Cherish your new commitment to GOD. Break away from the downward pull of negative friends and people in 2014.
