



<u>Part II of Mortgage Eve Opener</u>

I have a few suggestions before you purchase a home: 1) Save up enough money to avoid paying PMI (Property Mortgage Insurance). **PMI** is extra **insurance** that lenders require from most homebuyers who obtain loans that are more than 80 percent of their new home's value. 2) Wait 5 to 10 years where you and your spouse can save \$100,000 to \$200,000 to buy the house in cash or at least have a small loan. Of course you are saying that is ridiculous /impossible, but if you have been reading my articles for the past 5 years I laid out several obtainable plans to reach the above goals. Please look at the Real Life Scenario below:

Original Loan \$180,000......Mortgage Payment \$1200 a Month

A Year of mortgage payments = \$14,400

5 Years of mortgage payments = \$72,000

*Note 5 years later the Original Loan Current Value is now \$162,000 *

Meaning out of 5 years you paid \$72,000, but only \$18,000 went to paying down the loan the rest went towards interest. So \$54,000 is just thrown away. So this is the case in point why you need save your money or make plans to pay your house off early like in 7 years to 15 years.

If you are currently in a home, here are a few simple steps to cut your Mortgage Years in HALF.

Contact your Mortgage Company and ask to get on a bi-weekly or bimonthly payment plan. They can tell you how their specific system works at your mortgage company. Instead of paying your home loan once a month, consider bi-weekly (or twice monthly) payments and knock seven years off your mortgage term. With bi-weekly mortgages, one half of your payments are due on the 1st and 15th of each month. This reduces your interest payments, and you'll save money over the life of the loan.
