Are you in Good Hands?

Get ready for more pain at the pump, and in your wallet this year. Reports suggest that gas prices may climb above \$4 per gallon in much of the country. Here are a few tips to maximize MPG.

1. Accelerate less, Drive more: Cars use the most gas as they accelerate. Gently braking or avoiding brakes all together is the best way to prevent unnecessary acceleration.

2. Slow down: Speeding on the highway can be a tough habit to break, but slowing from 70mph to 65mph can reduce fuel consumption by up to 7 percent.

3. Straighten up: Improper alignment not only wears your tires faster, but it also causes your engine to work harder therefore burning more gas.

5. Check your tire pressure. Under-inflated tires cause your engine to burn more gas. Even minor under-inflation can cost up to six cents per gallon in lost efficiency

5. You Need to Be Prepared and Use Your Resources:

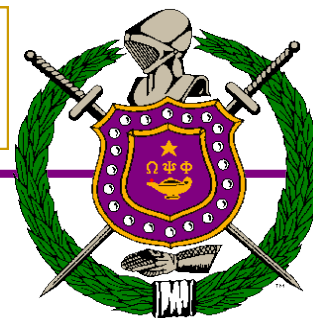
